SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2249 by House Committee on Commerce, Labor and Economic Development

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2249 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2249 would provide workers compensation death benefits for any wholly dependent child who is enrolled in grades nine through 12 in a public or private high school or in a GED program.

The Department of Labor estimates the bill would have no fiscal effect on Department operations or on the payment of workers compensation death benefits.
