SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2352 by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2352 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2352 would amend the Kansas Code of Civil Procedure to make evidence of a juvenile adjudication for a crime inadmissible for purposes of impeaching a witness, if that same crime, committed by an adult, would be considered a misdemeanor involving dishonesty or false statement.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates that any fiscal effect associated with HB 2352 would be negligible.
