SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2392 by House Committee on Appropriations

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2392 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2392 would abolish the Kansas Partnership Fund and repeal the Local Government Infrastructure Improvement Projects Loan Program.

According to the Kansas Department of Commerce, enactment of HB 2392 would have no fiscal effect because there are no monies in the Kansas Partnership Fund.

The League of Kansas Municipalities and the Kansas Association of Counties indicate the bill would abolish a source of financial assistance to local governments wanting to improve public infrastructure. Because neither organization knows how many local governments might be planning to use the Local Government Infrastructure Improvement Projects Loan Program, a fiscal effect cannot be estimated.
