SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 185 by Senate Committee on Commerce

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 185 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 185 would allow a board of county commissioners with an established redevelopment district located within a federal enclave in the county to authorize, by resolution, any person, firm or corporation to install, maintain and operate utilities serving the redevelopment district. SB 185 would also allow a board of county commissioners to delegate these powers to a board of directors if a board of directors oversees the redevelopment district as authorized by the board of county commissioners. Action taken in regard to the utilities of a redevelopment district would be subject to certain rules and guidelines set forth in the bill.

The Kansas Association of Counties estimates SB 185 would have no fiscal effect.
