SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 217 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 217 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 217 would update certain statutes referencing the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services necessitated by ERO 41 which consolidates the financing arm of Medicaid in the Kansas Department of Health and Environment Division of Health Care Finance. The ERO also renames the former Department on Aging as the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services (KDADS), moves all disability waiver and mental health services from the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services to KDADS, and renames the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services as the Department for Children and Families.

The enactment of SB 217 would have no fiscal effect because it is a bill that makes technical corrections to statutory references.
