SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 280 by Senate Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 280 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 280 would amend the Kansas Parentage Act by repealing and replacing the section that prescribes how parenting plans and child custody decisions are made. Under current law, orders for legal custody, residency and parenting time are prescribed by KSA 23-2201 et seq. The bill would require orders for legal custody, residency and parenting time to be prescribed by KSA 23-3201 et seq.

The Office of Judicial Administration does not estimate the bill to have any fiscal effect on the judiciary. The Department for Children and Families does not estimate the bill to have any fiscal effect on the agency.
