AN ACT concerning cities and counties; dealing with certain volunteer 1 2 activities of governing body members; amending K.S.A. 19-205 and 3 repealing the existing section.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 19-205 is hereby amended to read as follows: 19-6 7 205. (a) Except as provided by K.S.A. 12-344, and 12-345, and amendments thereto, and K.S.A. 2007-2016 Supp. 12-363 and 12-365, and 8 9 amendments thereto, no person holding any state, county, township or city 10 office shall be eligible to the office of county commissioner in any county in this state. 11

12 (b) Nothing in this section shall prohibit the appointment of any 13 county commissioner to any state board, committee, council, commission or similar body which is established pursuant to statutory authority, so 14 15 long as any county commissioner so appointed is not entitled to receive 16 any pay, compensation, subsistence, mileage or expenses for serving on 17 such body other than that which is provided by law to be paid in 18 accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-3223, and amendments 19 thereto.

20 (c) <u>Nothing in this section shall prohibit</u> Any county commissioner 21 from serving may serve as a volunteer in any capacity for an emergency 22 medical service or ambulance service or as a volunteer fire fighter-and-23 receiving the usual compensation or other remuneration for such-

24 volunteer services, but such commissioner shall not receive any-

25 compensation or other remuneration for such volunteer activities {and

26 may receive the usual compensation or other remuneration for such 27 volunteer services}.

28 New Sec. 2. (a) A member of a city governing body shall not be 29 prohibited from serving may serve as a volunteer in any capacity for an 30 emergency medical service or ambulance service or as a volunteer fire 31 fighter, but such member shall not receive any compensation or other 32 remuneration for such volunteer activities {and may receive the usual 33 compensation or other remuneration for such volunteer services}.

(b) Nothing in section shall prohibit any member of a city governing 34
