AN ACT concerning employment; relating to pay statements; amending 2 K.S.A. 44-320 and repealing the existing section.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. K.S.A. 44-320 is hereby amended to read as follows: 44-6 320. Each employer shall: (a) Upon the request of the employee, notify 7 such the employee in writing or as required by a collective bargaining 8 agreement, of the rate of pay and of the day and place of payment.

9 (b) Upon the request of the employee, notify-such the employee in 10 writing or through a posted notice maintained in a place accessible to-his 11 employees or as required by a collective bargaining agreement, of any 12 changes in the arrangements specified in subsection (a) of this section 13 prior to the time of such changes.

14 (c) Upon the request of the employee, make available to-such the employee in writing or through a posted notice maintained in a place 15 16 accessible to-his employees or as required by a collective bargaining agreement, employment practices and policies with regard to vacation pay, 17 sick leave and any other benefits to which the employee is entitled and 18 19 which have a direct bearing upon wages payable.

20 (d) Furnish each employee, upon request by such the employee, with 21 an itemized statement of deductions made from his the employee's wages 22 under K.S.A. 44-319, and amendments thereto, for each pay period such 23 deductions are made. *If requested by the employee, the statement or a copy* 24 of the statement shall be delivered to the employee in printed or written 25 form on each day that wages are paid. Statements shall be furnished and 26 delivered in printed or written form at no cost to the employee.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 44-320 is hereby repealed.
