1 AN ACT concerning the department of corrections; relating to the Lansing
2 correctional facility.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) On the effective date of this act, the provisions of
6 section 214(e) of chapter 104 of the 2017 Session Laws of Kansas are
7 hereby declared to be null and void and shall have no force and effect.

8 (b) On the effective date of this act, notwithstanding the provisions of
9 any statute, the department of corrections shall not expend any moneys
10 appropriated from the state general fund or from any special revenue fund
11 or funds for fiscal year 2018 or fiscal year 2019 as authorized by chapter
12 104 of the 2017 Session Laws of Kansas or any appropriation act of the
13 2018 regular session of the legislature, to enter into a lease – purchase
14 agreement or issue bonds to design, construct and equip a correctional
15 institution in Lansing, Kansas, or to demolish the existing correctional
16 institution in Lansing, Kansas, without prior specific authorization by an
17 act of the legislature or an appropriation act of the legislature.

18 (c) During the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, and the fiscal year
19 ending June 30, 2019, in addition to the other purposes for which
20 expenditures may be made from the state general fund or any special
21 revenue fund or funds for fiscal year 2018 or fiscal year 2019 by the
22 department of corrections by chapter 104 of 2017 Session Laws of Kansas
23 or any appropriation act of the 2018 regular session of the legislature,
24 expenditures shall be made by the department of corrections from the state
25 general fund or any special revenue fund or funds to issue a subsequent
26 request for proposal for the design, construction and equipment of a
27 correctional institution in Kansas. Prior to issuing such request for
28 proposal, the department of corrections shall seek input from mental health
29 providers, the Kansas sentencing commission, local communities
30 interested in a correctional facility and any other stakeholders deemed
31 necessary by the department of corrections. Further, the department of
32 corrections shall first advise and consult on any such project with the joint
33 committee on state building construction prior to issuing the request for
34 proposal. The Kansas development finance authority shall assist the
35 department of corrections on the potential financing options for such
36 proposed correctional institution as requested by the department.

1 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
2 publication in the Kansas register.
