1 AN ACT regulating traffic; concerning the operation of golf carts; required
2 lighting for night use; amending K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 8-15,108 and
3 repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 8-15,108 is hereby amended to read as
7 follows: 8-15,108. (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a golf
8 cart: (1) On any interstate highway, federal highway or state highway; (2)
9 on any public highway or street within the corporate limits of any city
10 unless authorized by such city; or (3) on any street or highway with a
11 posted speed limit greater than 30 miles per hour.

12 (b) The provisions of subsection (a) shall not prohibit a golf cart from
13 crossing a federal or state highway or a street or highway with a posted
14 speed limit in excess of 30 miles per hour.

15 (c) A golf cart shall be operated on any public street or highway only
16 during the hours between sunrise and sunset, *unless equipped with: (1)*
17 *Lights as required by law for motorcycles; and (2) a properly mounted*
18 *slow-moving vehicle emblem as required by K.S.A. 8-1717, and*
19 *amendments thereto.*

20 (d) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the uniform act
21 regulating traffic on highways.

22 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 8-15,108 is hereby repealed.

23 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
24 publication in the statute book.
