AN ACT concerning the Kansas medical assistance program; relating to the administration and provision of state medicaid services.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) On the effective date of this act, the secretary of health and environment and the secretary for aging and disability services shall commence planning for the provision of state medicaid services under the Kansas medical assistance program using a capitated managed care delivery system. The medicaid delivery system in existence on the effective date of this act shall be continued until January 1, 2022, without the imposition of any new eligibility requirements or limitations to receive state medicaid services that are not in effect on January 1, 2018, unless otherwise required by state or federal law, and until a revised delivery system is developed and approved by an act of the legislature and by the United States centers for medicare and medicaid services. In developing the revised delivery system, the secretary of health and environment and the secretary for aging and disability services shall consult with the KanCare improvement ad hoc committee in existence on the effective date of this act.

- (b) In accordance with the provisions of subsection (a), the secretary of health and environment, the secretary for aging and disability services and the secretary of administration shall negotiate for the renewal of contracts in effect on January 1, 2018, for the administration and provision of state medicaid services under the Kansas medical assistance program until January 1, 2022. Subject to the provisions of subsection (a), the secretary of health and environment and the secretary for aging and disability services shall submit the revised capitated managed care delivery system plan to the United States centers for medicare and medicaid services for a waiver authorizing the state of Kansas to administer on and after January 1, 2022, state medicaid services under the Kansas medical assistance program using a capitated managed care delivery system in accordance with the revised plan.
- (c) The secretary of health and environment and the secretary for aging and disability services, jointly, shall submit annually on or before January 10, 2019, and each year thereafter until 2022, a report to the house committee on health and human services and the senate committee on

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public health and welfare upon the progress of planning under subsection (a) and any recommendations deemed appropriate.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
