1 AN ACT concerning the Kansas department for aging and disability
2 services; relating to security police officers; training requirements;
3 amending K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 76-12a17 and repealing the existing
4 section.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 76-12a17 is hereby amended to read as
8 follows: 76-12a17. No person employed by the secretary for aging and
9 disability services shall receive a permanent appointment as a security
10 police officer as authorized by K.S.A. 76-12a16, and amendments thereto,
11 unless such person has been awarded a certificate by the secretary ~~of~~
12 ~~corrections for aging and disability services~~ attesting to such person's
13 satisfactory completion of a basic course of instruction specified by the
14 secretary ~~for aging and disability services and the secretary of corrections~~.
15 Such certificate shall be awarded only following verification of completion
16 of the training provided by ~~both departments~~ *the Kansas department for*
17 *aging and disability services*. Such certificate shall be effective during the
18 term of a person's employment, except that any person who has terminated
19 employment with the secretary ~~for aging and disability services~~ for a
20 period exceeding one year shall be required to be certified again.

21 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 76-12a17 is hereby repealed.

22 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
23 publication in the statute book.
