1 AN ACT authorizing the construction of a permanent statue honoring
2 Dwight D. Eisenhower on the state capitol grounds.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) The capitol preservation committee shall approve plans
6 to place a permanent statue of Dwight D. Eisenhower on the state capitol
7 grounds pursuant to K.S.A. 75-2269, and amendments thereto.

8 (b) The secretary of administration is hereby authorized to receive
9 moneys from any grants, gifts, contributions or bequests made for the
10 purpose of financing the creation and construction of the statue and its
11 pedestal and to expend such moneys for the purpose for which received.
12 The secretary of administration shall remit all moneys so received to the
13 state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and
14 amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state
15 treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit
16 of the Eisenhower statue fund. No public funds shall be expended for the
17 purpose of financing the creation or construction of the statue and its
18 pedestal.

19 (c) There is hereby established in the state treasury the Dwight D.
20 Eisenhower statue fund. Expenditures from the fund may be made for the
21 purposes of creating and constructing the statue and its pedestal and for
22 such other purposes as may be specified with regard to any grant, gift,
23 contribution or bequest. All such expenditures shall be made upon
24 warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to
25 vouchers approved by the secretary of administration or the secretary's
26 designee.

27 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
28 publication in the statute book.
