Testimony on HB2092 (neutral, written)
House Elections Committee
Tuesday, February 19, 2019

Chairman Sutton and members of the Committee:

I offer this neutral testimony on behalf of the Office of Secretary of State on HB2092 - allowing for same day voter registration in Kansas.

If implemented, HB2092 would have a fundamental change to Kansas election operations. A few weeks ago, Secretary Schwab appeared before this committee offering an overview of the office and asked lawmakers to refrain from making any dramatic changes to state election laws so we could visit with county clerks and train and educate staff on the many constitutional requirements of the office.

Thoughtful time and deliberation are essential to implementing the substantial change proposed under HB2092. Although this proposal has benefits, equal concerns exist with the impact it may have on election security, county election officials and the Kansas electorate. We are committed to working with lawmakers and local election officials to review these proposals and seek feedback from other states where such practices are already in effect. Respectfully, we ask the Committee to give our office time to review HB2092 and similar subject matter causing major changes to Kansas election law.
