My story begins the saddest day of my life. Dec 7, 2018. I drove to pick up my children from school and back home my mind was lost because I had just received the news that a family member had died and I had a traffic accident, I was hit by another vehicle and it started there My biggest fear of being arrested and leaving my children homeless because my husband was working in another state.

I do not have a driver's license but I have the need and obligation to drive daily to cover the basic needs of my family how to take and pick up children to school, go to stores and supermarkets, pay bills, medical appointments and even outside the place where we live and countless other activities.

I had never been given a traffic ticket, much less been involved in an accident until that fatal day.

Not only they gave me a traffic ticket but they gave me a summons to court and in the situation that I find myself I had to request the service of a lawyer.

Fortunately, the police officers who attended the accident were very kind and understandable with me and my children and in the same court. But the fear of knowing that your problems will be bigger by the mere fact of not having a driver's license is enough to make you feel bad and with much regret.

At the end of the court they transferred me to another office that despite the kindness of the staff did not end with my fear and my sadness because not only did they take my fingerprints but they took pictures and opened a criminal file and that was a great humiliation because They put them at the level of thieves, kidnappers, murderers, etc.; just for the fact of not having a driver's license.

If I had a license, this situation would not have come to this.

I hope you listen and put your hand on your heart and approve this request.
