My name is Carrie McKinzie and I'm a 35 year old mother of three, wife, Church lady, and sign language interpreter.

About three years ago, I was diagnosed with Chiari Malformation and had brain surgery. One of the (many) ongoing struggles I have is debilitating headaches typically diagnosed as migraines.

To give you an example of how severe my headaches are, in December I spent 16 days and nights in Wesley Hospital in Wichita with a headache they couldn't get a hold on. Actually as I write this today (Feb 12) I'm

My family needs me to be able to function. When I'm suffering from this pain, there are days and weeks at a time when I'm absolutely useless and unable to do anything. I haven't been able to be fully employed in several years.
