#### **MEMORANDUM**

Re: Prison Bed Impact Assessment, SB 81 – Changing penalties for crimes related to motor

vehicles.

### **IMPACT ASSESSMENT**

- This bill will not have an immediate impact on prison admissions and bed space. It **may** have an impact if offenders' probations are revoked and are sentenced to prison, but it cannot be determined at this time.
- This bill **will** have an impact on the workload of the Commission, but it cannot be determined at this time.

### **SUMMARY OF THE BILL**

**Section 1.** This section amends K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-1568 by adding **operating a stolen motor vehicle** to the list of acts listed in subsection (b) that, if committed during a police pursuit along with the other elements, shall make the driver guilty as provided in (a)(2).

This section adds language stating that any term of confinement imposed for a violation of subsection (a)(1)(B) or (b) shall be served consecutively to any other term of confinement imposed for any other violation committed in whole or in part during the act of violating subsection (a)(1)(B) or (b).

**Section 2.** This section amends K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 21-5801 by creating another exception to the general rule that theft less than \$1,500 is a class A nonperson misdemeanor. Under this bill, theft of property that is a motor vehicle valued at less than \$1,500 is a severity level 10, nonperson felony. **Currently, such violation would be a class A nonperson misdemeanor.** 

**Section 3.** This section amends K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 21-5804 by stating that in a prosecution for theft as defined in K.S.A. 21-5801, and such theft is of a motor vehicle, fleeing or attempting to elude a police officer as defined in K.S.A. 8-1568(a)(1)(B) or (b), shall be prima facie evidence of intent to permanently deprive the owner of the motor vehicle of the possession, use or benefit thereof.

**Section 4.** This section states that K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-1568, 21-5801 and 21-5804 are hereby repealed. **Section 5.** This section states that the act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.

#### **FINDINGS**

- In FY 2018, **363** offenders were convicted the crime of fleeing or eluding a law enforcement officer under K.S.A. 8-1568. Of this number:
  - o 118 (32.5%) were sentenced to prison; and
  - o **245** (66.5%) were sentenced to probation.
  - o All of the offenders were sentenced at severity level 9, except one at severity level 10.
- In FY 2018, **1,019** offenders were convicted of the crime of theft under K.S.A. 21-5801. Of this number:
  - o **274** (27%) were sentenced to prison and
  - o **745** (73%) were sentenced to probation.
    - **890** (87.3%) were sentenced at severity level 9;
    - **64** (6.3%) were sentenced at severity level 10;
    - 57 (5.6%) were sentenced at severity level 7;
    - 1 (0.1%) was sentenced at severity level 8; and
    - **7** (0.7%) were sentenced at severity level 5.
- Currently, no data exists for violation of K.S.A 8-1568 operating a stolen motor vehicle or theft of a motor vehicle valued at less than \$1,500.

## **IMPACT ASSESSMENT**

- This bill will not have an immediate impact on prison admissions and bed space. It may have an impact if offenders' probations are revoked and are sentenced to prison, but it cannot be determined at this time.
- This bill will have an impact on the workload of the Commission, but it cannot be determined at this time.
