Re: Prison Bed Impact Assessment - **HB 2470 - Clarifying jurisdiction and supervision of offenders in a certified drug abuse treatment program.**

IMPACT ASSESSMENT

- **Impact on Prison Admissions:** This bill will have **no** impact on prison admissions.
- **Impact on Prison Beds:** This bill will have **no** impact on prison beds.
- **Impact on the Commission Workload:** This bill would result in **no** additional workload of the Commission.

SUMMARY OF THE BILL

- **Section 1.** K.S.A. 2019 Supp. 21-6610 is amended to allow the originating district court to transfer jurisdiction to another district court for offenders sentenced pursuant to K.S.A. 21-6824 (SB 123) with the concurrence of the receiving district court and all parties.
- **Section 2.** K.S.A. 2019 Supp. 21-6824 (SB 123) is amended to read if offender is permitted to go from the judicial district of the sentencing court, the court may, pursuant to K.S.A. 2019 Supp. 21-6610, and amendments thereto transfer supervision over that judicial district to another and either transfer or retain jurisdiction of the offender.
- **Section 3.** K.S.A. 2019 Supp. 21-6610 and 21-6824 are hereby repealed.
- **Section 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.

FINDINGS

- This bill does not address sentencing outcomes.
