SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2137 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2137 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2137 would remove the June 30, 2019 expiration date for the Kansas Open Records Act (KORA) exception on licensing and examining records for money transmitters. The bill would require these records to continue to be exempt from disclosure under KORA and would instead be held as confidential.

According the Office of the State Bank Commissioner, enactment of HB 2137 would have no fiscal effect.
