SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2335 by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2335 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2335 would add state retirees, offenders under the supervision of the Department of Corrections, Kansas residents, contractors who are working on a project for a governmental or charitable organization, or any business located in Kansas to the list of entities authorized to purchase prison-made goods.

The Department of Corrections estimates there would be a fiscal effect on the operations of the agency and Kansas Correctional Industries; however, the Department cannot estimate what the effect might be. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2335 is not reflected in *The FY 2020 Governor's Budget Report*.
