SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2400 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2400 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2400 would create the Kratom Consumer Protection Act under the Kansas Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act to regulate the manufacture, preparation, distribution and sales of products containing kratom. The bill would establish penalties for false labeling or compounding and selling certain types of kratom mixtures and would prohibit dealers from selling or otherwise providing kratom products to individuals under 18 years of age. In addition, the bill would establish legal remedies for damages resulting from violations of the Act. The Kansas Department of Agriculture would be required to adopt rules and regulations for the administration and enforcement of the Act.

The Kansas Department of Agriculture does not expect enactment of HB 2400 to have any effect on either expenditures or revenues for the agency.
