SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2649 by Representative Warren

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2649 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2649 would permit disabled persons to display a wheelchair emblem on a personalized license plate.

The Kansas Department of Revenue estimates that HB 2649 would increase administrative expenditures by \$61,949 from the State General Fund in FY 2021 for system changes, testing, project management hours, updating policy and procedures and for contractual services. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2649 is not reflected in *The FY 2021 Governor's Budget Report*.
