**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 134 by Senate Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 134 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 134 would clarify that the crime of “counterfeiting currency” includes counterfeiting both currency and notes. The bill would add possession of a computer to the list of items used in counterfeiting currency.

The Office of Judicial Administration estimates enactment of SB 134 would have a negligible fiscal effect on Judicial Branch operations.

The Kansas Sentencing Commission estimates enactment of SB 134 could have an effect on prison admissions and beds; however, the Commission cannot estimate an effect. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 134 is not reflected in *The FY 2020 Governor’s Budget Report*.
