SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 17 by Senate Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 17 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 17 would remove certain exceptions related to individuals operating a motorcycle in the state by requiring the individual to have a class M driver's license.

The Department of Revenue indicates SB 17 would require updates to manuals and staff training, and increase applications for motorcycle licenses which may increase wait times at some offices. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 17 is not reflected in *The FY 2020 Governor's Budget Report*.
