**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 423 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 423 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 423 would establish the Sedgwick County Urban Area Nuisance Abatement Act which would set the procedures for repair or demolition of any nuisance in Sedgwick County. The bill would require the property landowner to cover the costs of any repair or demolition related to the Act. The bill would exclude any land, structures, machinery, or motor vehicles used for agricultural purposes.

The Kansas Association of Counties states that SB 423 may have a fiscal effect on Sedgwick County administrative costs, but the costs are unknown. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 423 is not reflected in *The FY 2021 Governor's Budget Report*.
