**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 442 by Senate Committee on Utilities

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 442 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 442 would require, upon written request by a Board of Public Utilities customer, that the Kansas Corporation Commission provide a comparison of any “rule, charge, practice or procedure that differs and the extent to which it differs,” from that of electric public utilities that are regulated by the Kansas Corporation Commission.

The Kansas Corporation Commission states that enactment of SB 442 in its current form would have no effect on agency operations.
