**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 483 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 483 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Current law requires not less than 30.0 percent of the products used in the manufacture of domestic table and fortified wine by a farm winery to be grown in Kansas unless the Director of the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control authorizes a lesser proportion. SB 483 would remove this requirement. The bill would also make technical corrections.

According to the Kansas Department of Revenue, enactment of SB 483 would have no fiscal effect on agency operations.
