SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 94 by Senate Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 94 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 94 would establish a minimum course duration of four hours for motor vehicle accident prevention courses. The bill would also clarify that state or federal agencies may approve motor vehicle accident prevention courses in addition to the National Safety Council.

According to the Insurance Department, enactment of SB 94 would have no fiscal effect on the agency because the bill does not designate or authorize the Insurance Department to be responsible for the review of the motor vehicle accident prevention courses.
