Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 25-101b is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-101b. (a) At the general election held in 1978 and each four-(4) years thereafter, there shall be elected a treasurer for the state of Kansas, whose term of office shall be four-(4) years beginning on the second Monday in January next succeeding-such the treasurer's election. In case of a vacancy in-such the office, the governor shall appoint some suitable person to serve for the unexpired term and until a successor is elected and qualified.

- (b) No person shall serve more than two successive terms as treasurer for the state of Kansas.
 - Sec. 2. K.S.A. 40-106 is hereby amended to read as follows: 40-106. (a) At the general election held in 1978 and each four (4) years thereafter, there shall be elected a commissioner of insurance for the state of Kansas, whose term of office shall be four—(4) years beginning on the second Monday in January next succeeding—such the commissioner's election. In case of a vacancy in—such the office the governor shall appoint some suitable person to serve for the unexpired term and until a successor is elected and qualified.
- (b) No person shall serve more than two successive terms as commissioner of insurance for the state of Kansas.
- 24 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 25-101b and 40-106 are hereby repealed.
- Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
