AN ACT concerning children and minors; relating to adoption; date of final decree; amending K.S.A.-2018 2019 Supp. 59-2134 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A.-2018 2019 Supp. 59-2134 is hereby amended to 6 7 read as follows: 59-2134. (a) (1) Upon the hearing of the petition, the court shall consider the assessment and all evidence, including evidence relating 8 to determination of whether or not the court should exercise its 9 jurisdiction, offered by any party in interest. If the adoption is granted, the 10 11 court shall enter a final decree of adoption, which terminates parental 12 rights if not previously terminated.

13 (2) (A) Except as provided in subparagraph (B), a final decree of adoption shall take effect upon the filing of the judgment, unless the court 14 makes a specific finding of fact that it is in the best interests of the child. 15 16 that the decree shall take effect at an earlier date as the court shall direct.

(B) If the child to be adopted is 16 or 17 years of age, the court 17 18 may order a final decree of adoption to take effect at an earlier date. 19 In no case shall such decree take effect more than two years earlier than 20 the filing of the judgment or before a bona fide relationship was 21 established between the child to be adopted and the prospective adoptive 22 parent. In considering the date that a decree shall take effect, the court 23 may consider a prospective adoptive parent's deployment or mobilization 24 and the interest of siblings being adopted together.

25 (3) If an adoption has had the final decree of adoption entered by the 26 court prior to July 1, 2019 **2020**, the court may modify such final decree of 27 adoption pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (2), at the request of an 28 adoptive parent within 180 days after the enactment of this section.

29 (4) The provisions of paragraph (2) shall not apply to an adoption 30 when the person to be adopted has attained the age of majority before the 31 petition for adoption is filed.

(b) If the adoption is denied, the court shall enter appropriate orders. 32 33 Such orders may include an order giving temporary custody of the child to another person or agency for a period not to exceed 30 days pending 34 35 termination of the instant case or a new case being filed. 36

(c) The costs of the adoption proceedings shall be paid by the
