AN ACT concerning adult care homes; requiring annual dementia care training for employees thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

- Section 1. (a) (1) The following employees of an adult care home shall successfully complete 12 hours of dementia care training annually:
- (A) An employee that is required to be licensed by the state board of healing arts, the board of nursing or the behavioral sciences regulatory board to practice a profession related to such employment;
- (B) an adult care home administrator required to be licensed pursuant to K.S.A. 65-3501 et seq., and amendments thereto;
- (C) an adult care home operator required to be registered pursuant to the operator registration act;
- (D) a nurse aide, as defined in K.A.R. 26-39-100(qq), required to be certified by the secretary for aging and disability services; and
- (E) a medication aide, as defined in K.S.A. 65-1,120, and amendments thereto, required to be certified by the secretary for aging and disability services.
- (2) New employees shall successfully complete six hours of dementia care training within the first 15 days of employment and six additional hours within the first 90 days of employment.
- (b) (1) All other employees of an adult care home not specified in subsection (a) shall successfully complete four hours of dementia care training annually.
- (2) New employees shall successfully complete four hours of dementia care training within the first 30 days of employment.
- (c) The secretary of aging and disability services shall approve the content and manner of dementia care training required by this section.
- (d) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the adult care home licensure act.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
