Subject: SB 39

SB 39 would amend the current annual renewal deadlines for certain fees, registrations, permits and licenses relating to livestock and domestic animals from June 30th to September 30th.

The sections with renewal deadlines that would be changed to September 30th are:

- Sections 1 and 2, K.S.A. 47-1001e and 47-1002: Licenses concerning the operation of a public livestock market;
- Section 3, K.S.A. 47-1208: All licenses and permits issued under chapter 47, article 12 relating to the disposal of dead animals;
- Section 4, K.S.A. 47-1503: Licenses to operate a feed lot;
- Section 5, K.S.A. 47-1805: Livestock dealer registration; and
- Section 6, K.S.A. 47-2101: Permits for the possession of domesticated deer.

Section 7 would amend K.S.A. 47-1831 to allow the animal health commissioner to require reimbursement for the actual cost of calfhood vaccination tags. Additionally, the commissioner would have the option to charge a processing fee for such tags, but the processing fee could not exceed \$0.25 per tag.

SB 39 would take effect upon publication in the Kansas register.
