

Rep. Sean Tarwater, Chair Members of the House Committee on Commerce March 15, 2021 Re: Support of SB 124, STAR Bonds Renewal

On behalf of the Olathe Chamber of Commerce, its Board of Directors, and its members, I respectfully ask the House Commerce Committee to support SB 124 and renew STAR Bond legislation rather than allow this economic development tool sunset.

The success of STAR Bonds in Kansas has been an impactful economic development tool for communities of all sizes throughout Kansas. Although Olathe has not used STAR Bonds as an economic development tool this incentive will continue to give Kansas a significant advantage in attracting development and creating destination tourism sites that in turn bring visitors to our state and create entertainment opportunities that will help retain our workforce talent in Kansas.

Kansas communities, large and small, throughout Kansas have benefited from the STAR Bonds program by developing new attractions that draw tourists to their communities. By adding major business facilities into the definition of eligible areas this tool will only be a more innovative tool in the toolbox for the Olathe community to expand and attract new business development. Ultimately, expanding STAR Bonds will bring jobs and growth to Olathe and the state of Kansas.

Additionally, our members support the addition of several "guardrail "provisions added in SB 124 that clarify and expand requirements that must be fulfilled prior to consideration or approval of a project. These include having the Secretary selecting and overseeing the feasibility study consultants, addition of the "visitor expectation" element of the proposal, impact study focus on state and local economies and the net return analysis. The Olathe Chambers believes these provisions will provide greater assurance of the integrity of the proposed projects.

Finally, our members are supportive of making STAR Bonds a permanent tool and avoid the need to renew it on a regular basis. By doing so, Kansas will assure the planned projects the stability and consistency they need to thrive in our state and ultimately assuring more projects and investment to Kansas.

The State of Kansas and its communities have profited from the STAR Bonds program that generates new jobs and new revenue. We ask that you vote to preserve STAR Bonds by supporting SB 124 and enhancing and retaining a valuable economic development tool for the State of Kansas.
