Chairman Huebert, Vice Chairman Thomas, Ranking Minority Stogsdill and Members of the Committee,

SB 51 requires the State Department of Education and the State Department of Children and Families to prepare a Kansas foster care children annual report card. The bill specifies the data that is to be reported and sets January 15th as the date the report card is to be delivered to the Education Committees in both the House and the Senate.

Since this was not an issue considered by the Kansas Board of Education to be on their list of Legislative Priorities, we are providing neutral testimony. However, we do see value in such a report card. We all need to be concerned about the level of success reached by foster care children. Education is a large contributor to the potential success of all children. Foster care children have long been a concern of the Legislature.
