thefts of mail

IMPACT ASSESSMENT

- This bill **may** have an impact on prison admissions and bed space, but it cannot be determined at this time.

SUMMARY OF THE BILL

This bill makes theft of property that is mail of the value of less than \$1,500 from three separate locations within a period of 72 hours as part of the same act or transaction or in two or more acts or transactions connected together or constituting parts of a common scheme or course of conduct a **severity level 9**, **nonperson felony**.

This bill also defines "mail" to mean a letter, postal card, package or bag sent through the United States postal service or other delivery service, or any other article or thing contained therein, or a sealed article or thing addressed to a person;

FINDINGS

- In FY 2019, there were **963** convictions for **felony theft** under K.S.A. 21-5801. All convictions were nonperson.
 - o 230 (23.8%) offenders were sentenced to prison
 - Severity Level 5 3 (1.3%)
 - Severity Level 7 14 (6.1%)
 - Severity Level 9 201 (87.4%)
 - Severity Level 10 12 (5.2%)
 - o 733 (76.2%) offenders were sentenced to **probation**
 - Severity Level 5 5 (0.6%)
 - Severity Level 7 48 (6.6%)
 - Severity Level 9 639 (87.2%)

- Severity Level 10 41 (5.6%)
