Senate Bill 394 **Opposition**

Written Testimony

To Whom It May Concern: I am writing with concern about Senate Bill 394, requiring all advanced voting ballots be returned by 7pm Election Day. I encourage you to NOT support SB 394 so that all citizens can vote safely.

First, mail ballots are a critical part of our election process, allowing all citizens to exercise their right to vote, including the elderly and persons with disabilities. During the pandemic, my parents, also Kansas residents, would not have been able to vote had they not had access to mail ballots. They are in their seventies and have been very cautious about keeping themselves safe. We also have an immuno compromised child who is at high risk of covid complications. My husband and myself chose to vote with advance ballots which we dropped off in the boxes outside our county election office.

Second, the 7pm requirement does not allow for any extenuating circumstances such as mail service experiencing delay for any reason when sending the ballot to the voter or upon the ballot's return. Delays happen with shipping and mailing all the time. Transport error with no fault of the voter is clearly not fair.

I encourage you to NOT support SB 394 so that all citizens can effectively vote.
