
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2057 by House Committee on Commerce, Labor and Economic Development

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2057 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2057 would amend the Club and Drinking Establishment Act to allow a licensed manufacturer to be issued up to one drinking establishment license that would be located within two miles of the licensed premises specified in the manufacturer's license. Under this situation, the drinking establishment license would be allowed to sell the alcoholic liquor manufactured by its manufacturer's licensee but would also be required to acquire all other beer, cereal malt beverage, wine, and spirits from a distributor, retailer, or farm winery licensed under the Kansas Liquor Control Act.

The Department of Revenue indicates that HB 2057 would have no fiscal effect. The Department indicates the bill would require it to update the manufacturer and drinking establishment handbooks; however, those costs are estimated to be negligible.
