**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2299 by House Committee on Judiciary


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2299 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, a search warrant is required to be executed within 96 hours from the time of issuance. HB 2299 would require that a search warrant be executed within ten days from the date of issuance.

The Office of Judicial Administration states enactment of HB 2299 would have a negligible fiscal effect on the operations of the Judicial Branch.

The Kansas Association of Counties states enactment of the bill could create additional costs if a county must continually monitor a location.
