
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2309 by Representative Xu

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2309 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2309 would create the Agricultural Equipment Right-to-Repair Act. The bill would require an original equipment manufacturer to provide documentation, parts and tools under “fair and reasonable terms” as defined by the bill at a fair and reasonable cost. Violation of the Act would be an unclassified nonperson misdemeanor punishable by a fine of \$5,000.

According to the Kansas Department of Agriculture, enactment of HB 2309 would have no fiscal effect on the agency.
