
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2498 by Representative Fairchild, et al.

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2498 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2498 would prohibit the Secretary of the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) from requiring a child to receive a COVID-19 vaccine for care in a child care facility or for attendance at any school. The bill would take effect upon its publication in the *Kansas Register*.

KDHE states there would be no fiscal effect associated with the enactment of HB 2498.
