
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2528 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2528 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2528 would add inflatable devices owned and operated by a nonprofit organization to the list of items not included in the definition of “amusement ride” under the Kansas Amusement Ride Act. This would exempt such devices from inspection and permit requirements through the Kansas Department of Labor.

The Kansas Department of Labor states that enactment of HB 2528 would not have a fiscal effect on the agency.
