
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2594 by House Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2594 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2594 would exempt certain modifications on antique vehicles related to repair and restoration from vehicle identification number offense seizures and dispositions unless the person knows or has reason to know that the vehicle is stolen.

The Kansas Department of Revenue indicates HB 2594 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures.
