
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2649 by House Committee on K-12 Education Budget

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2649 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2649 would prohibit any virtual school in Kansas from offering or providing any financial incentive for a student to enroll in a virtual school.

The enactment of HB 2649 would have no fiscal effect on state aid to school districts or administrative costs to the Department of Education.
