
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 451 by Senate Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 451 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, the Secretary of Wildlife and Parks is required to issue, free of charge, a permanent license to hunt, fish, and furharvest to any person residing in Kansas who submits proof that they are at least one-sixteenth Indian by blood and maintains enrollment on a tribal membership roll maintained by a federally recognized tribe. SB 451 would remove the requirement to provide proof that they are at least one-sixteenth Indian by blood.

The Department of Wildlife and Parks states that enactment of SB 451 would not have a fiscal effect.
