
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 89 by Senate Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 89 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 89 would amend existing law to exempt trucks, trailers or semi-trailers hauling agricultural forage commodities within the state from the place of production to a market or place of storage from the secured loads statute. The bill would not exempt hay bales or other packaged/bundled forage commodities from being secured for transport.

The Kansas Department of Transportation indicates that enactment of SB 89 would have no fiscal effect on the agency.
