AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to distinctive license plates; providing for the daughters of the American revolution license plate.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

5 Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2023, any owner or lessee of one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of 6 7 20,000 pounds or less who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance with 8 the provisions of this section, may be issued one daughters of the 9 American revolution license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. 10 Such license plate shall be issued for the same time as other license plates 11 upon proper registration and payment of the regular license fee as provided 12 in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and either the payment to the 13 county treasurer of the logo use royalty payment or the presentation of the 14 annual logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection (b).

(b) The daughters of the American revolution may authorize the use 15 16 of the organization's logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by this section. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee may apply annually to the 17 18 daughters of the American revolution for use of such logo. Such owner or 19 lessee shall pay an amount of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 to the 20 daughters of the American revolution as a logo use royalty payment for 21 each such license plate to be issued. The logo use royalty payment shall be 22 paid to either:

(1) The daughters of the American revolution, which shall issue to the
 motor vehicle owner or lessee, without further charge, a logo use
 authorization statement that shall be presented by the motor vehicle owner
 or lessee at the time of registration; or

(2) the county treasurer.

28 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may 29 make application for such license plate not less than 60 days prior to such 30 person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished 31 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plate shall 32 either provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in 33 subsection (b) or pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment. 34 Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance of 35 the license plate under this section shall be made by the owner or lessee in 36 a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon forms furnished by

1 the director.

2 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be 3 transferable to any other person.

4 (e) The director of vehicles may transfer a daughters of the American 5 revolution license plate from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.

6 (f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made annually, 7 upon payment of the fee prescribed in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments 8 thereto, and in the manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132(b), and amendments thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until 9 such applicant provides to the county treasurer either the annual logo use 10 authorization statement provided for in subsection (b) or the payment of 11 12 the annual royalty payment. If such statement is not presented at the time of registration or sent by the daughters of the American revolution, or the 13 annual royalty payment is not made to the county treasurer, the applicant 14 15 shall be required to comply with the provisions of K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the county treasurer of 16 17 such person's residence.

(g) The daughters of the American revolution shall provide to all
 county treasurers an electronic mail address where applicants can contact
 the daughters of the American revolution for information concerning the
 application process or the status of such applicant's license plate
 application.

(h) The daughters of the American revolution, with the approval of
 the director of vehicles, shall design a plate to be issued under the
 provisions of this section.

(i) As a condition of receiving the daughters of the American
revolution license plate and any subsequent registration renewal of such
license plate, the applicant shall consent to the division authorizing the
division's release of motor vehicle record information, including the
applicant's name, address, royalty payment amount, plate number and
vehicle type to the daughters of the American revolution and the state
treasurer.

(j) The collection and remittance of annual royalty payments by the
 county treasurer shall be subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,141(h),
 and amendments thereto.
