1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to distinctive license plates;
2 providing for the daughters of the American revolution license plate
3 ***and the order of the eastern star license plate.***
4

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2023, any owner or lessee of
7 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of
8 20,000 pounds or less who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance with
9 the provisions of this section, may be issued one daughters of the
10 American revolution license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck.
11 Such license plate shall be issued for the same time as other license plates
12 upon proper registration and payment of the regular license fee as provided
13 in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and either the payment to the
14 county treasurer of the logo use royalty payment or the presentation of the
15 annual logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection (b).

16 (b) The daughters of the American revolution may authorize the use
17 of the organization's logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by
18 this section. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee may apply annually to the
19 daughters of the American revolution for use of such logo. Such owner or
20 lessee shall pay an amount of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 to the
21 daughters of the American revolution as a logo use royalty payment for
22 each such license plate to be issued. The logo use royalty payment shall be
23 paid to either:

24 (1) The daughters of the American revolution, which shall issue to the
25 motor vehicle owner or lessee, without further charge, a logo use
26 authorization statement that shall be presented by the motor vehicle owner
27 or lessee at the time of registration; or

28 (2) the county treasurer.

29 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may
30 make application for such license plate not less than 60 days prior to such
31 person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished
32 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plate shall
33 either provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in
34 subsection (b) or pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment.
35 Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance of
36 the license plate under this section shall be made by the owner or lessee in

1 a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon forms furnished by
2 the director.

3 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be
4 transferable to any other person.

5 (e) The director of vehicles may transfer a daughters of the American
6 revolution license plate from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.

7 (f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made annually,
8 upon payment of the fee prescribed in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments
9 thereto, and in the manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132(b), and amendments
10 thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until
11 such applicant provides to the county treasurer either the annual logo use
12 authorization statement provided for in subsection (b) or the payment of
13 the annual royalty payment. If such statement is not presented at the time
14 of registration or sent by the daughters of the American revolution, or the
15 annual royalty payment is not made to the county treasurer, the applicant
16 shall be required to comply with the provisions of K.S.A. 8-143, and
17 amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the county treasurer of
18 such person's residence.

19 (g) The daughters of the American revolution shall provide to all
20 county treasurers an electronic mail address where applicants can contact
21 the daughters of the American revolution for information concerning the
22 application process or the status of such applicant's license plate
23 application.

24 (h) The daughters of the American revolution, with the approval of
25 the director of vehicles, shall design a plate to be issued under the
26 provisions of this section.

27 (i) As a condition of receiving the daughters of the American
28 revolution license plate and any subsequent registration renewal of such
29 license plate, the applicant shall consent to the division authorizing the
30 division's release of motor vehicle record information, including the
31 applicant's name, address, royalty payment amount, plate number and
32 vehicle type to the daughters of the American revolution and the state
33 treasurer.

34 (j) The collection and remittance of annual royalty payments by the
35 county treasurer shall be subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,141(h),
36 and amendments thereto.

37 ***Sec. 2. (a) On and after January 1, 2023, any owner or lessee of***
38 ***one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of***
39 ***20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance***
40 ***with the provisions of this section, may be issued one order of the***
41 ***eastern star license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such***
42 ***license plate shall be issued for the same time as other license plates***
43 ***upon proper registration and payment of the regular license fee as***

1 *provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and either the*
2 *payment to the county treasurer of the logo use royalty payment or the*
3 *presentation of the annual logo use authorization statement provided for*
4 *in subsection (b).*

5 *(b) The order of the eastern star may authorize the use of the*
6 *organization's logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by this*
7 *section. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee may apply annually to the*
8 *order of the eastern star for use of such logo. Such owner or lessee shall*
9 *pay an amount of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 to the order of*
10 *the eastern star as a logo use royalty payment for each such license plate*
11 *to be issued. The logo use royalty payment shall be paid to either:*

12 *(1) The order of the eastern star, which shall issue to the motor*
13 *vehicle owner or lessee, without further charge, a logo use authorization*
14 *statement that shall be presented by the motor vehicle owner or lessee at*
15 *the time of registration; or*

16 *(2) the county treasurer.*

17 *(c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may*
18 *make application for such license plate not less than 60 days prior to*
19 *such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and*
20 *furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license*
21 *plate shall either provide the annual logo use authorization statement*
22 *provided for in subsection (b) or pay to the county treasurer the logo use*
23 *royalty payment. Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or*
24 *truck and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be made*
25 *by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles*
26 *upon forms furnished by the director.*

27 *(d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall*
28 *be transferable to any other person.*

29 *(e) The director of vehicles may transfer an order of the eastern*
30 *star license plate from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.*

31 *(f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made*
32 *annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the*
33 *manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132(b), and amendments thereto. No*
34 *renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until such*
35 *applicant provides to the county treasurer either the annual logo use*
36 *authorization statement provided for in subsection (b) or the payment of*
37 *the annual royalty payment. If such statement is not presented at the*
38 *time of registration or faxed by the order of the eastern star, or the*
39 *annual royalty payment is not made to the county treasurer, the*
40 *applicant shall be required to comply with the provisions of K.S.A. 8-*
41 *143, and amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the county*
42 *treasurer of such person's residence.*

43 *(g) The order of the eastern star shall provide to all county*

1 *treasurers an electronic mail address where applicants can contact the*
2 *order of the eastern star for information concerning the application*
3 *process or the status of such applicant's license plate application.*

4 *(h) The order of the eastern star, with the approval of the director*
5 *of vehicles, shall design a plate to be issued under the provisions of this*
6 *section.*

7 *(i) As a condition of receiving the order of the eastern star license*
8 *plate and any subsequent registration renewal of such license plate, the*
9 *applicant shall consent to the division authorizing the division's release*
10 *of motor vehicle record information, including the applicant's name,*
11 *address, royalty payment amount, plate number and vehicle type, to the*
12 *order of the eastern star and the state treasurer.*

13 *(j) The collection and remittance of annual royalty payments by the*
14 *county treasurer shall be subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,141(h),*
15 *and amendments thereto.*
