AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to antique vehicles; requiring
 applicants using a bill of sale for antique vehicle certificates of title to
 be licensed dealers unless providing proof of insurance and an
 application for registration; authorizing local county sheriffs to perform
 antique vehicle VIN inspections; amending K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 8-170
 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

9 Section 1. K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 8-170 is hereby amended to read as 10 follows: 8-170. (a) Upon the transfer of ownership of any vehicle 11 registered under the foregoing provisions of this act, its registration and 12 right to use the license plates-thereon on such vehicle shall expire-and 13 thereafter. Upon such transfer of ownership, there shall be no transfer of 14 any registration, and the license plates shall be removed by the owner 15 thereof, and it shall be unlawful for any person other than the person to 16 whom such license plates were originally issued to have the same in possession. In the case of a transfer of ownership of a registered vehicle, 17 18 the original owner of the license plates may register another antique 19 vehicle under the same license plate designation, upon application therefor 20 and the payment of a fee of \$1.50. On and after January 1, 2000, Any 21 model year license plate transferred shall comply with the provisions-of 22 subsection (e) of K.S.A. 8-172(c), and amendments thereto.

(b) Upon the transfer and sale of a registered vehicle by any person,
the new owner thereof, before using a vehicle on the highways of this
state, shall make application to the division for registration of the vehicle.

(c) Certificate of title:

27 Application for certificate of title on an antique vehicle shall be (1)28 made by the owner or the owner's agent upon a blank form to be furnished 29 by the division and shall contain such information as the division shall 30 determine necessary. The division may waive any information requested 31 on the form if it is not available. Except as provided in paragraph (4), for 32 any antique vehicle having a model year prior to 1950, the application 33 together with a bill of sale for the antique vehicle shall be accepted as 34 prima facie evidence that the applicant is the owner of the vehicle and the 35 certificate of title shall be issued for such vehicle. If the application and 36 bill of sale are used to obtain a certificate of title for any antique vehicle

1 having a model year of 1950 or later, the certificate of title shall not be 2 issued until an inspection in accordance with subsection (a) of K.S.A. 8-3 116(a), and amendments thereto, has been completed and the applicant 4 complies with the requirements provided in paragraph (4). The vehicle 5 inspection required by this paragraph may be performed by a county 6 sheriff that is located in the county where the application for certificate of 7 title will be submitted. The certificate of title shall be delivered to the 8 applicant. The certificate shall contain the words "antique vehicle."

9 (2) The certificate of title shall contain upon the reverse side a form 10 for assignment of title to be executed by the owner. *Except as provided in* 11 *paragraph (4)*, a certificate of title may be issued under the provisions of 12 this act without an application for registration.

13 (3) The fee for each original certificate of title so issued shall be \$10. 14 The certificate of title shall be good for the life of the antique vehicle, so long as the same is owned or held by the original holder of the certificate 15 16 of title, and shall not have to be renewed. In the event of a sale or transfer 17 of ownership of an antique vehicle for which a certificate of title has been 18 issued under the provisions of this subsection, the holder of such 19 certificate of title shall endorse on the same an assignment thereof, with 20 warranty of title in form printed thereon, as prescribed by the director, and 21 the transferor-must shall deliver the same to the buyer at the time of 22 delivery of the vehicle. The buyer shall then present such certificate of 23 title, assigned as aforesaid, to the director or an authorized agent of the 24 director, whereupon a new certificate of title shall be issued to the buyer, 25 the fee therefor being \$10.

26 (4) Applications for a certificate of title using a bill of sale for proof 27 of ownership pursuant to paragraph (1) shall only be allowed if the 28 applicant is a licensed vehicle dealer as defined in K.S.A. 8-2401, and 29 amendments thereto. Applicants for a certificate of title using a bill of sale 30 for proof of ownership who are not licensed vehicle dealers shall provide 31 proof of insurance pursuant to K.S.A. 40-3104, and amendments thereto, 32 and an application for registration of the vehicle at the same time that 33 such person applies for a certificate of title.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 8-170 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
