AN ACT concerning animals; relating to transporting animals into the 1 state; authorizing the animal health commissioner to assess a civil 2 3 penalty for violations relating thereto; amending K.S.A. 47-607c and 4 repealing the existing section. 5 6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:* 7 Section 1. K.S.A. 47-607c is hereby amended to read as follows: 47-8 607c. (a) Any person-or persons violating or failing who intentionally or knowingly violates or intentionally or knowingly fails to comply with the 9 provisions of this act shall be deemed guilty of a class-A C nonperson 10 11 misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of 12 not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) nor more than one thousand-13 dollars (\$1,000), or by imprisonment in the county jail not less than thirty 14 (30) days nor more than one (1) year, or by both such fine andimprisonment. 15 16 (b) In addition to any other penalty provided by law, any person who violates K.S.A. 47-607, and amendments thereto, the special permit 17 18 requirements of K.S.A. 47-607a, and amendments thereto, or rules and 19 regulations promulgated pursuant to K.S.A. 47-607d, and amendments 20 thereto, may incur a civil penalty in an amount not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 for each-such violation. In the case of a continuing-21 22 violation, every day such violation continues may be deemed a separate 23 violation shipment into the state. 24 (c) No civil penalty shall be imposed pursuant to this section except 25 upon the written order of the duly authorized agent of the animal health 26 commissioner to the person who committed the violation. Such order shall 27 state the violation, the civil penalty to be imposed and the right of the

person to appeal to the commissioner. Within 20 days of such notification,
any such person may make written request to the commissioner for a
hearing in accordance with the Kansas administrative procedure act.

(d) Any civil penalty recovered pursuant to this section shall be
remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with K.S.A. 75-4215, and
amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state
treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit
of the state general fund.

- 1 related to animals and the suspected transportation of such animals into
- 2 the state in violation of K.S.A. 47-607, and amendments thereto, the
- 3 special permit requirements of K.S.A. 47-607a, and amendments thereto,
- 4 or rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to K.S.A. 47-607d, and
- 5 amendments thereto, in the possession of any person be submitted to the
- 6 commissioner for review within a reasonable time. Failure to cooperate
- 7 with any such request shall be considered a violation of this act.
- 8 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 47-607c is hereby repealed.
- 9 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 10 publication in the statute book.
