1	AN ACT concerning income taxation; establishing a checkoff for
2	contributions to the Kansas historic site fund.
3	
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
5	Section 1. (a) For all tax years commencing after December 31, 2022,
6	each Kansas state individual income tax return form shall contain a
7	designation as follows:
8	Kansas Historic Site Fund. Check if you wish to donate, in addition to
9	your tax liability, or designate from your refund,\$1,\$5,\$10 or
10	\$ to historic site number
11	(b) For purposes of administration of this section, the director of
12	taxation of the department of revenue shall assign a historic site number to
13	all state-owned historic sites administered by the Kansas state historical
14	society in order for a taxpayer to choose the historic site that will receive
15	the donation. The instructions accompanying the individual income tax
16	return shall include a brief description of all state-owned historic sites
17	administered by the Kansas state historical society and identify each
18	historic site number assigned for purposes of a contribution pursuant to
19	this section.
20	(c) The director of taxation of the department of revenue shall
21	determine annually the total amount designated for contribution to the
22	Kansas historic site fund pursuant to subsection (a) and shall report such
23	amount to the state treasurer, who shall credit the entire amount thereof to
24	the Kansas historic site fund. Such fund is hereby established in the state
25	treasury and shall be administered by the state historical society
26 27	department of revenue. In the case where donations are made pursuant to subsection (a), the director shall remit the entire amount thereof to the state
28	treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and
29	amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state
30	treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit
31	of the Kansas historic site fund. All moneys deposited in such fund <i>shall</i>
32	be distributed to the historic sites in accordance with the selections of
33	taxpayers and shall be used for the purpose of the operation, maintenance
34	and preservation of the state-owned historic site of the taxpayer's choice
35	such sites. All expenditures from such fund shall be made in accordance
36	with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and

- 4 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
- 5 publication in the statute book.
